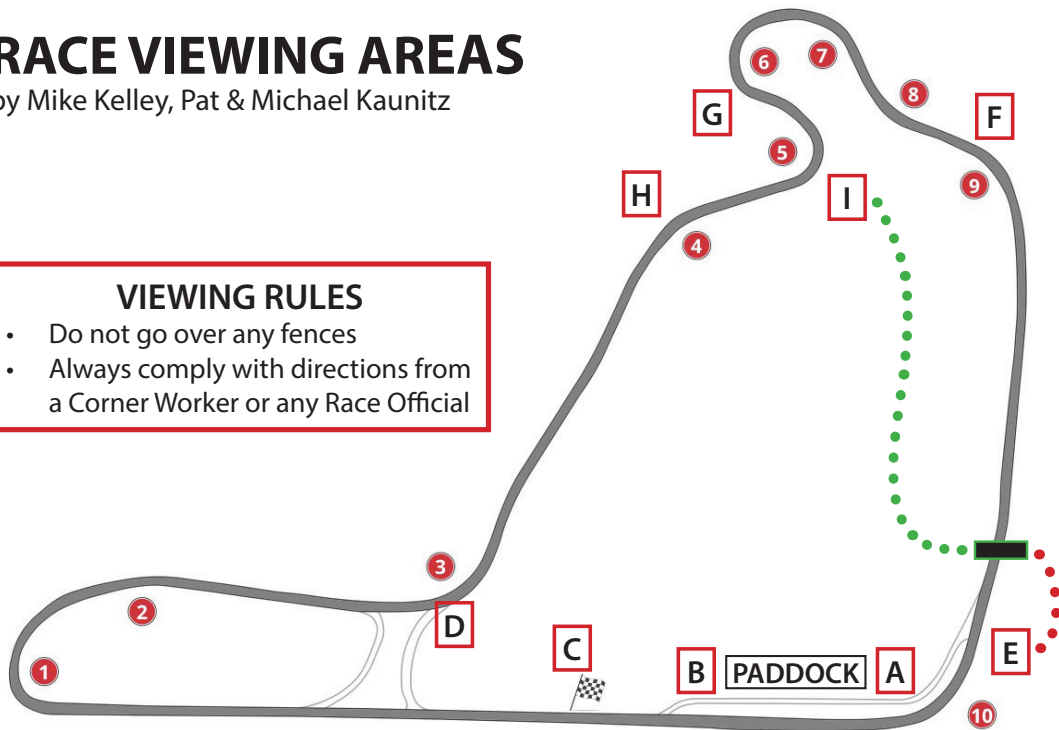

- Do not go over any fences
- Always comply with directions from a Corner Worker or any Race Official

 Viewing Spots are in Red Squares

Spot	Name	How To Get There	What Is Interesting There
A	Turn 10 Tower	In the Paddock at the beginning of the Grid.	See cars coming under the bridge, coming around Turn 10, and cars pitting if they need to.
B	Pit Out Tower	In the Paddock at the end of the Grid.	Please walk around the back of all Emergency vehicles. See cars staging on Grid, cars coming down the front straight.
C	Control Tower Hill	Walk to the hill around the Control Tower.	See the Starter (best place to watch the start of a race). See cars approaching Turn 1 and coming through 2 & 3.
D	Turn 3	Walk down the hill from the Control Tower towards Turn 3.	Go to the far right of the fence line to see good cars entering this blind turn. Go to the far left end of the fence to see cars head over the hill and disappear.
E	Turn 10 Grandstands	Leave the Paddock, take a right after you cross the bridge following the dotted red line.	Lots of passing occurs in Turn 10 as cars try to carry as much momentum as they can to get a goo run down the front stretch, It's a fast turn and cars may appear to be moving sideways. This is a good photo spot in the morning.
F	Turn 9 Grandstands	Near the Main Gate.	Take a seat up at the top of the Grandstands. Almost half of the turns are in your view. Cars are streaming down the hill (Turns 4 & 5), around the carousel (Turns 6 & 7), and back towards the bridge (Turns 7, 8, 9).

RACE VIEWING AREAS (Continued)

Spot	Name	How To Get There	What Is Interesting There
G	Turn 5 Bleachers	Take the road away from the main gate keeping the track on your left. Park near the fence on the left.	The tiny bleachers allow you to get very close to the cars - you can practically see inside them. From the far left of the fence down low between the fence rails, car will seem as if they are coming right out of your photos.
H	Turn 5	Up the hill right next to the Turn 4 corner station.	Stand right next to the Turn 4 corner station. For photos, it's a very tight angle over the concrete barrier, but you can get some shots of the cars hanging on through the turn and also see cars coming over the hill from Turn 3.
I	Infield Grandstands	Unpaved adventure! Take the dirt & gravel road immediately in front of you as you cross the bridge going toward the paddock (green dotted line on map). Keep bearing right until out of the woods and in a field.	There are two Grandstands here; one straight ahead and one off to the left. To your right you will be able to see cars going up the hill. Straight ahead you will see cars transitioning from right to left hand turns. Up to your left you can see drivers trying to out-brake each other as they race into Turn 5.

How We Determine Who Gets the Trophies

We have three sets of awards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place for the “Rock the Summit” PCA Club Race this weekend, one set each for Sprint Races (Green, Blue and Red Groups), Vintage Races (Silver Group), and Enduro Races.

Sprint Races: We award one set of sprint race trophies based on the combined results of the two Sprint races on Saturday. We combine the results as follows:

- Total the results of the two sprint races (1 point for first, 2 points for second, etc.)
- Lowest total receives first place, second lowest is second, etc.
- Ties are broken based on the lowest lap time in the two races. If identical, then we go to the second-best lap time, etc.
- Racers must finish both races to qualify for a trophy.

Vintage Races: We award one set of vintage race trophies based on the combined results of the three Vintage races, one on Friday and two on Saturday. Racers are awarded points in all 3 races based on finishing position in class. Two points are awarded for starting the race, and then 10 points for 1st, 7 for 2nd, 5 for 3rd, 4 for 4th, 3 for 5th, 2 for 6th and 1 for 7th or higher. We award first, second and third place trophies to the highest points totals, in order. All podium finishers receive trophies regardless of the number of cars in the class.

Enduro Races: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place stickers are awarded to those finishing positions in each class for its enduro race on Sunday.
